Intro

Short introduction explaining the transition from the Citrus Canker Eradication Program to the Citrus Health Response Program. The intro states that the purpose of the 1:40 minute DVD is to present a comprehensive overview of key CHRP components in a user-friendly format that lends itself to future training opportunities.

Citrus Nurseries

Presents an overview of the new guidelines for citrus nurseries. DPI nursery certification supervisor tours a Florida citrus nursery that meets the new requirements.

Citrus Budwood

Bureau Chief for DPI's citrus budwood registration presents a brief overview of why clean budwood sources are critical to the industry and why facilities have been moved to north Florida to protect budwood sources.

Business Plans

Business plans are an important component of compliance agreements. Completing the plans will assist growers with the management of citrus pests and diseases, give a general feel for trends and conditions, and provide documented evidence of disease control objectives that are important to phytosanitary trade agreements. Examples of how to complete the plans are also presented.

Decontamination

A comprehensive discussion of why decontamination is necessary and how to properly decontaminate equipment and personnel. An in-field demonstration is presented.

Citrus Greening

This segment on citrus greening is divided into three sections:

Citrus Canker

This segment on citrus canker is divided into three sections:
